



Mrs. Thomasina Mary Kelly Dalman

July 1, 1935 - December 22, 2014

Surrounded by her family, Thomasina Dalman, 79, passed away at her home Monday, December 22, 2014, after losing her brave battle with cancer.

Mrs. Dalman was born July 1, 1935, in White Plains, NY, to the late Thomas and Elizabeth Kelly. She graduated from White Plains High School, the Laboratory Institute of Merchandising and Fashion of New York and the Barbizon School of Modeling. She majored in retailing which she made her early career. She married Roy L. Dalman in 1968 and lived in Greenwich, CT, for 34 years before moving to Asheville in 2002. She was passionate about her ice skating and her Irish heritage and had many fond memories of her travels to visit her relatives in England and Ireland.
