William "Cal" Calhoun Frue, III, 53, died Tuesday, December 14, 2010 at his residence. Born in Durham, NC, he was a lifelong resident of Asheville.

Cal was a CPA and operated his accounting firm in Asheville. He was a 1975 graduate of Asheville Country Day School and held a Bachelor of Science degree from The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Cal was a member of the North Carolina Association of Certified Public Accountants and the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. He served as an officer of The Preservation Society of Asheville & Buncombe County.

While well known for his keen intellect, Cal is equally revered for his tireless efforts for the benefit of the disadvantaged and for his love and affection for his friends and family.

An avid outdoorsman, Cal enjoyed camping and boating and always made time to share with his nieces and nephews: Timmy Acton, Turner Acton, and Tori Acton of Neenah, Wisconsin; Will Frue of Asheville; and Bailey Frue and Cameron Frue of Asheville.

His survivors include his parents, William C. Frue, Jr. of Asheville and Eloise Saunders Frue of Asheville; brothers, John "Jack" C. Frue and Michael C. Frue both of Asheville; sister, Victoria Eloise Frue Acton of Neenah, WI; and

uncle and aunt, Mr. & Mrs. John T. Saunders, Jr. of Leicester, NC.
