Winifred Lorene (Renie) Davis Miner, 88, of Asheville passed away Thursday, November 21, 2013 after a brief illness at Memorial Mission Hospital in Asheville NC. Renie was active for over 45 years at Sharon Methodist Church in Lewisville, NC and also in the Forsyth Extension Homemakers, 4-H Clubs, Contact, United Methodist Women and other service oriented programs in and around Forsyth County. Since Jack's retirement from Piedmont Airlines they both became very involved in missions and helping Jack start the Diengenga Trade School at Lodja in the Democratic Republic of the Congo. The Central Congo Annual Conference renamed the school in 2012 to the Jack & Renie Miner Technical Institute in recognition of their continued heartfelt support for the advancement of education in the region.

A memorial service will be held at 5:00 pm, Sunday, November 24, 2013 at Sharon United Methodist Church in Lewisville, NC followed by visitation with the family. Additionally, a memorial service will be held at 3:30 pm, Tuesday, December 17, 2013 at Brooks-Howell Home in Asheville, NC. 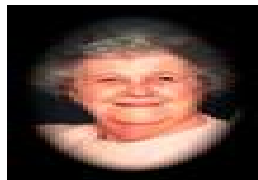
